Rent Payment Assistance: Rent payment assistance is available through the following Arkansas Community Action Agencies. Income and eligibility requirements will vary based on funding source and county of residence; income range: 30% of median income (e.g., between \$13,440 and \$20,970 annually, based on residency) up to 125% of federal poverty level (e.g., \$32,750/year for a family of 4). All programs operate based on funding availability.

Utility Assistance Information: All community action agencies operate the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program. Households at or below 60% of median income (e.g., \$3261/month for a family of 4) are eligible for assistance several times per year. Some assistance is based on household size and income; some programs also include a requirement that there is a past due balance on the utility account.
